Public Notice – 2022 Los Angeles FamilySource Centers (FSS) Evaluator Request For Proposals (RFP)
On Thursday, May 4, 2023, the Community Investment for Families Department (CIFD) released the Request For Proposals (RFP) for FamilySource Centers (FSS) System Evaluator.

The FamilySource System (FSS) is a place-based social service program delivered through the City's FamilySource Centers (FSSCs), which are strategically located within high-need areas of the City of Los Angeles (City). The FSS is a multisector program of anti-poverty services and initiatives. Established in 2009, the FSS is a network of 16 centers which work to break the cycle of intergenerational poverty. FSSCs are intended to be one-stop centers that provide a robust menu of social services and outreach to low- and moderate-income parents and guardians with children up to the age of 17. The FSS is a place-based FSS has functioned as a performance-driven, outcome-oriented system with two primary measures of success: increased family income and increased academic achievement.

The FSS is currently being procured to have up to 20 FSSCs serving Angeles across the City beginning on July 1, 2023. CIFD plans to continue with a place-based model but refine it to better respond to the evolving needs of City residents. Through the FSS RFP, the FSS will have a refined focus on providing social services, including housing and other basic needs, working with families to build a more financially secure future, and supporting participating students' academic achievement. Performance evaluations of all FSSCs and system-wide assessments of the economic impact of the FSS on the local economy have been conducted annually. This RFP seeks to solicit a contractor that will provide program evaluation services for the entire FamilySource System.

BOARD ORDER NO. 598 REVISED TENTATIVE RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION COMMISSIONERS CITY OF LOS ANGELES

WHEREAS, the Board of Transportation Commissioners provides for the regulation of non-taxi, vehicle-for-hire permittees in the City of Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, the Board approved Board Order 598 on June 9, 2011, related to the regulation of all drivers, attendants, and operators of for-hire vehicles, non-ambulatory passenger vehicles, gurneys, and litter vans; and

WHEREAS, the Board found that an amendment to Board Order 598 is necessary to provide updated and consistent regulation of drivers, attendants, and operators of private ambulance, non-ambulatory passenger vehicles, gurneys, and litter vans, which will greatly benefit the public, the drivers, the attendants, the regulated companies, and the Department's regulatory effectiveness; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Board Order 598 is hereby amended and that all drivers, attendants, and operators of private ambulance, non-ambulatory passenger vehicles, gurneys, and litter vans, shall be governed by the following rules and regulations until modified, amended, or repealed by the Board of Transportation Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles. All prior rules and regulations in conflict with the following are hereby canceled and suspended by this Order.

Rules and Regulations Applicable to Drivers and Attendants of Non-Ambulatory Passenger Vehicles:

- All applicants for driver and/or attendant permits must furnish acceptable proof of right to work in the United States. Acceptable documents may include, but shall not be limited to: Birth Certificates, U.S. Passport or Passport Card, Social Security Card, Certificate of Naturalization, Restricted Social Security Card without Required documents, Permanent Resident Card or Alien Registration Receipt (Form I-55), or any other I.N.S. document that shows the legal right to work in the United States.
- Rules and Regulations Applicable to Drivers and Attendants of Non-Ambulatory Passenger Vehicles:

- The applicant shall:
 - Be at least 18 years of age.
 - Possess a valid California Driver's License.
 - Possess a current American Red Cross Standard first aid card or its equivalent.
 - Possess a certificate of cardiopulmonary resuscitation training, meeting American Heart Association or American Red Cross standards.

- New driver and attendant applicants shall have the ability to communicate and comprehend English, written and spoken. Applicants shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Department their English comprehension proficiency by questions and answers derived from a Driver/Attendant application shall be used to establish the standard for such testing.

1. AMBULANCE DRIVERS AND ATTENDANTS

- Any person who meets the qualifications and training required by this Order and holds a valid ambulance driver's permit or ambulance attendant's permit issued by the City of Los Angeles Department of Transportation may serve as a medical transportation vehicle or non-ambulatory passenger vehicle driver or attendant.
- Shall have the ability to communicate in English, written and spoken, as measured by standards and procedures established by the Department.

- PROHIBITIONS:
The Department shall refuse to issue a permit to an applicant who:
 - Is required to register as a sex offender under Section 290 of the Penal Code.
 - Has a record of habitual or excessive use or addiction to intoxicating beverages, narcotics or dangerous drugs.
 - Rules and Regulations Applicable to Non-Ambulatory Passenger Vehicles

1. All non-ambulatory Passenger Vehicles which have never held a Department issued Permit shall be no older than 10 years old as defined by the initial date the vehicle was first manufactured. Permitted vehicles older than 10 years as described above, may remain in service for up to five additional years provided they are inspected by a state certified automotive mechanic facility on an annual basis.
2. The vehicle shall be a full-sized van or larger and be equipped with:
 - Minimum interior height of 66 inches for vans 22 feet in length or less, and 68 inches for vans in excess of 22 feet in length.
 - Loading entrances, including an emergency exit, large enough to accommodate a passenger comfortably seated in a wheelchair, or wheelchair patients using any non-ambulatory, non-motorized mobility assistive device such as crutches or a four-footed walker. Entrances shall not be blocked in any way.
 - Seating area must have a clear floor space of 30" x 48" for a wheelchair.
 - Locking devices on all doors and all door latches which shall be operable from the inside and the outside.
 - Seat belts for the driver and all seated passengers.
 - Mechanisms that meet ADA requirements to secure wheelchairs to the vehicle and the passenger to the wheelchair.
 - Lift or ramp with a load capacity of at least 600 pounds.
 - A sturdy footstool, vehicle running board, or extra step at the entrance.
 - An interior light.
 - A portable, battery operated light.

- A GPS-based navigation system or other electronic location finder.
- Washable vinyl or similar impermeable material seat covers.
- Company name permanently affixed to the vehicle in lettering of at least 4 inches in height, and of a contrasting color which is easily visible in daylight from a distance of 50 feet. Each vehicle shall have the unit number permanently affixed to the right rear and left front fender areas in letters at least 4 inches in height and of a contrasting color which is easily visible in daylight from a distance of 50 feet.

- N. A properly inflated, usable spare wheel with tire, jack, and tire tools, or the ability to obtain reliable, fully contracted road services.
- O. A properly maintained 4-B; C or C1 dry powder or carbon dioxide fire extinguisher. Vaporizing liquid extinguishers shall not be used.
- P. A placard indicating that the odometer has been tested within the past year and that the odometer meets the requirements of the California Business and Professions Code, Section 17404.5. Weighing and Measuring Devices, Section 12500 et seq.
- Q. A No Smoking sign.
- R. A 10-Unit first aid kit, equivalent to one required for ANSI specifications, and maintained and properly filled with all necessary products at all times.

- S. A two-way communication system or cell phone capable of communication with a dispatcher under normal operating conditions.
- T. Vehicles permitted to transport gurney patients shall be equipped as above and also be equipped with:
 - At least one seat capable of being securely fastened to the vehicle shall be provided in the gurney area of the vehicle.
 - A device to hold the gurney securely in place.
