2. cashing, borrowing against, canceling, transferring, disposing of, or changing the beneficiaries of any insurance or other coverage, including health, automobile, and disability, held for the benefit of the parties and their minor children;
3. transferring, encumbering, pledging, hypothecating, conveying, or disposing of any property, real or personal, whether community, quasi-community, or separate, without the written consent of the other party or an order of the court, except in the usual course of business or for the necessities of life; and
4. creating a nonprobate transfer or modifying a nonprobate transfer in a manner that affects the disposition of property subject to the transfer, without the written consent of the other party or an order of the court. Before revocation of a nonprobate transfer can take effect or right of survivorship to property can be eliminated, notice of the change must be filed and served on the other party.
