A Notice of Preparation (NOP) has been prepared to notify agencies and interested parties that the City of Los Angeles (City) as the lead agency represented by the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) and Los Angeles Sanitation and Environment (LASAN) joint partners will prepare a Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the proposed Los Angeles Water Los Angeles Program (Program). LADWP and LASAN have partnered to implement the Program in a collaborative effort previously referred to as "Hyperion 2035" by LASAN, and "Operation NEXT" by LADWP. The City is proposing a framework to expand and strengthen the City of Los Angeles water supply portfolio by maximizing the production of purified recycled water, helping to ensure a resilient future for the region. The proposed Program would augment local water supplies by producing up to 230 million gallons per day of purified recycled water for the City and its customers. The amounts and locations of treatment will be determined through ongoing evaluation, but this program document will include consideration of full-scale optimization of Hyperion resources. The City invites agencies and the public to attend Program scoping meetings and provide comments on the scope and content of the environmental analysis to be included in the PEIR. The public comment period commences on August 28, 2025 and continues through October 2, 2025. WHEREAS, the California Government Code 53075.5 gives the City of Los Angeles the authority to set maximum taxicab meter rates to be charged to the public for taxicab service in the City of Los Angeles; and

WHEREAS, after considering evidence presented at a public hearing on August 21, 2025, together with the Department recommendations, the Board has determined that the following taxicab meter rates is justified; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found and determined that the following rate schedule and conditions are just, reasonable, nondiscriminatory and non-preferential for all companies; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the proposed following rate schedule and conditions are hereby fixed and established as the maximum rates and surcharges to be charged by permitted taxicab operators for service in the City of Los Angeles;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the technology fee established and being collected by the City of Los Angeles is hereby placed into a Special Fund created and managed by the LADOT to support technology hardware, software, operations and maintenance needed to continually manage regulatory programs related to its permittees.
