**ORDINANCE NO. 18889E**  
An ordinance amending Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4, Item No. 330 – Charges for Pilotage.

### THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Order No. 26-7416 passed and adopted by the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2026, amending Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4, b, and the same is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved, which Order is in words and figures as follows:

#### \*ORDER NO.

An Order of the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles amending Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4.

THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DOES HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4, adopted July 12, 1989, by Order No. 5837, and Ordinance No. 165,789, adopted April 10, 1990, as amended, is further amended as set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Director of Environmental Management has determined that the proposed action is statutorily exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15273 of the State CEQA Guidelines.

Section 3. The Board Secretary shall transmit to the City Council for approval the Order and Ordinance approving the amendment to Tariff No. 4 pursuant to City Charter Section 653(b).

Section 4. The Board Secretary shall execute the proposed Board Order and Ordinance amending Tariff No. 4, and, upon its publication, transmit the Order and Ordinance to the Chief Wharfing for implementation of the tariff change and posting of the amended Tariff No. 4 to the Port's website.

That, pursuant to the provisions of Section 653(b) of the City Charter, the Board of Harbor Commissioners shall have the power to suspend, modify or amend temporarily any of the rules or regulations, or any of the rates, tolls or charges prescribed by the aforesaid Order of the Board of Harbor Commissioners for periods not exceeding ninety (90) days, and shall have power to place in effect for a like period of time any temporary rule or regulation, rate, toll or charge for the Harbor District.

Exception 1: Three-fourths (3/4) the entering or leaving charge shall be assessed when vessel subject to the payment of pilotage is not piloted by a port pilot. (Subject to the minimum pilotage charge.)					
Exception 2: No intra-harbor shifting charge shall be assessed when entering vessels which anchor because of inclement weather or other causes beyond the control of such vessel, if such vessels proceed thence to berth immediately after such cause of delay ceases to exist.					
Exception 3: For the purpose of assessing pilotage charges against barges, the sum of the overall length plus the overall width will be used. When the barge and tug or towboat are combined as an integrated unit, pilotage charges shall be assessed on the overall length and gross tonnage of the combined unit.					
(c) The pilotage charges assessed for the services proffered or rendered by a port pilot are assessed in accordance with and based upon each and every one of the limitations, agreements, covenants and conditions set forth in Item 305. However, said pilotage charges do not include marine insurance insuring the vessel, her owners, master, operators and charterers against the consequences of acts, omissions or negligence of the port pilot. Upon reasonable notice given to the Port of Los Angeles, marine insurance will be provided on a "trip" basis in an amount specified up to a maximum limit of liability of \$1,000,000.00, the premium of which will be assessed at cost in addition to the pilotage charges specified above.					
The coverage provided will insure said vessel, her owners, master, operators and charterers, as their interests may appear, against those losses or physical damages of said vessel and against those legal liabilities and damages which arise from the consequences of acts, omissions or negligence of the port pilot; provided, however, that such insurance will provide coverage only for that proportion of losses, damages and liabilities sustained by the vessel, her owners, master, operators and charterers, proximately caused by acts, omissions or negligence of the port pilot; and that no coverage is provided for losses, damages and liabilities resulting from any other cause whatsoever.

An ordinance amending Subsection (a) of Section 4.115 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, pertaining to Legal Holidays for Employees, to rename the holiday observed on the last Monday in March from "Cesar E. Chavez's Birthday" to "Farm Workers Day."

### THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The list of days that shall be treated as holidays under Subsection (a) of Section 4.115 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code is amended as follows:

DELETE:

Farm Workers Day (the last Monday in March).
