NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the South Coast AQMD is considering the adoption of Proposed Amended Rule 1401 - New Source Review of Toxic Air Contaminants (PAR 1401). The objective of PAR 1401 is to ensure health risks are evaluated for new toxic air contaminants and clarify the assessment procedure used during the South Coast AQMD permitting process. PAR 1401 adds new toxic air contaminants and 8-hour reference exposure levels to Table 1. Also, proposed amendments will add an 8-hour hazard index and specific 8-hour hazard index 8-hour hazard index. Additional minor changes to rule language will be made for consistency and clarity.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that PAR 1401 will not be submitted for inclusion into the State Implementation Plan.
