Ordinance No.188984

An ordinance calling a Special Election to be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the Los Angeles Unified School District a Charter amendment regarding the following subject: Campaign Finance Rules Related to LAUSD 10418 and Governance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DO ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A Special Election is hereby called to be held in the Los Angeles Unified School District on November 3, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the Los Angeles Unified School District a Charter amendment regarding the following subject: Campaign Finance Rules related to LAUSD Elections.

Sec. 2. The full text of the Charter amendment to be submitted to the qualified voters to the accompanying Resolution of the City Council of the City of Los Angeles.

Sec. 3. The vote requirement for the Charter amendment to pass is a majority of the votes cast.

Sec. 4. The ballot title and question adopted by the City Council to be used at the Special Election for the Charter amendment shall be as follows and include a letter designation as determined by the City Council in accordance with applicable City and State law.

CAMPAIGN FINANCE RULES RELATED TO BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTIONS. CHARTER AMENDMENT

Shall the Los Angeles City Charter be amended to clarify the campaign finance rules for Board of Education elections and allow for changes by ordinance?

Sec. 5. To vote on the ballot measure, the voter shall mark the ballot next to the word "Yes" or the word "No." A "Yes" vote shall be counted in favor of adoption of the ballot measure and a "No" vote shall be counted against adoption of the ballot measure.

Sec. 6. The Special Election hereby called shall be, and hereby is ordered to be, consolidated with the City's General Municipal Election and the State General Election to be held in the City of Los Angeles on Tuesday, November 3, 2026.

Sec. 7. The vote centers for the Special Election shall be open as required and during the identical hours as the vote centers established in the California Elections Code and as administered by the County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk for the State General Election.

Sec. 8. The election precincts, vote centers, and officers of election for the Special Election shall be the same as those provided in the Los Angeles Unified School District for the State General Election, and the elections shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election. The list or order prepared by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk designating election precincts, vote centers, and election officers for the State General Election, is hereby approved, incorporated into, and made part of this ordinance.

Sec. 9. The City Clerk shall administer the filing, printing, and distribution of all items contained in the City's Voter Information Pamphlet as provided in the City Election Code, including impartial summaries, ballot arguments, and rebuttal arguments regarding City ballot measures. In other particulars, the Special Election shall be held and conducted as provided in State Elections Code 10418 and other applicable law for the holding of elections consolidated with the State General Election. The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles shall have authority to canvass the returns of the City's Election and transmit the certified election results to the City Council.

Sec. 10. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.

CITY ETHICS, ELECTIONS, AND GOVERNANCE CHARTER AMENDMENT

Shall the City Charter be amended to: increase the authority of the Police Department Inspector General and Fire Department Independent Assessor; prohibit Ethics Commissioners from running for certain elected offices for five years; and increase the number of campaign finance violations require City Council to meet at least weekly rather than the currently required three days per week; increase referendum petition signature requirements; and make other changes regarding ethics, elections and governance?
